

Fact Sheet 3 - Transport - A local government perspective

Commonwealth funding for Local Roads in 2024-25:

Roads to Recovery (\$m)	649.4
Black Spots (\$m)	131.6
Safer Local Roads and Infrastructure Program (\$m)	200

Increases to Roads to Recovery and Black Spot Program

The Australian Government has delivered on its promise to increase Roads to Recovery funding to \$1 billion per year:

- 2024-25 \$649.4 million
- 2025-26 \$799.2 million
- 2026-27 \$949 million
- 2027-28 \$999 million.



The Australian Government has increased funding for the Black Spot Program to \$150 million over the four years to 2027-28:

- 2024-25 \$131.6 million
- 2025-26 \$140 million
- 2026-27 \$140 million
- 2027-28 \$150 million.
